Resolution in Protest of Issuance of Retail Class A License
to Aman Liquor Store

Whereas, Yerom Gebremichael (“Applicant”) has applied for a Retail Class “A” License for a Liquor Store operation located at 3661 Georgia Avenue, NW (License No.: ABRA-088128);

Whereas, DC Code § 25-314 provides that in determining the appropriateness of an establishment for initial issuance of an alcohol license or transfer of a license to a new location, the ABC Board shall consider whether issuance of the license would create or contribute to an overconcentration of licensed establishments which is likely to affect adversely the locality, section, or portion in which the establishment is located;

Whereas, No fewer than six establishments selling alcohol (two class A and four class B) are currently located within 1,500 feet of 3661 Georgia Avenue with the nearest full service liquor store located at 3614 Georgia Avenue, NW, thus over saturating the market and adversely impacting public safety and property values;

Be It Resolved That:

1. Notice be sent to the ABRA stating that ANC 1A hereby protests the issuance of a Retail Class A License to the Applicant.
